



## Statement Regarding RoHS 2011/65/EU Compliance

To Our Valued Customer,

CPC manufactures quick disconnect couplings and connections made from a variety of metal, plastic, and elastomeric raw materials. This statement is to clarify the position of CPC on compliance with **“The Restriction of the Use of Certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (European Council Directive 2011/65/EU),”** commonly referred to as “RoHS 2.”

According to information provided from either our suppliers or raw material manufacturers, the materials and manufacturing processes used in standard and modified standard product lines do not possess levels of cadmium, lead, mercury, hexavalent chromium, PBB or PBDE beyond acceptable limits as identified in the RoHS 2011/65/EU regulation. Please be aware that Colder Products Company does not test products for these substances, and relies on declarations from our suppliers for conformance assurance.
